2M Net Suggested Operating Procedures

Call the Net to order with the following call-up:

Calling the Mid-MO Amateur Radio Club 2-Meter Net, calling the Mid-MO Amateur Radio Club 2-meter Net.

This is (your call) net control. My name is _____.

This net meets every Wednesday night at 8:00 p.m. local time on the Jefferson City Repeater.

ALL stations are welcome and encouraged to check-in to this net. You do not have to be a member of the Mid-MO Amateur Radio Club to join us. All stations are encouraged to join us on the Net.

The repeater is transmitting on 147 Megahertz with a negative offset. The Morse code letter "P" is transmitted for the courtesy beep when the 127.3 sub-audible CTCSS Tone is activated.

(Call for stations with EMERGENCY or PRIORITY traffic)

Stations with EMERGENCY or PRIORITY traffic please call now.

(Announce the date, time and location of the next MMARC meeting)

(Call for check-ins)

(Make a final call for late check-ins or re-checks)

(Thank all stations who have checked in and close the net)
